

**Tues., Sept. 15 - CHICAGO / EN ROUTE**

Today we depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport on our flight to Vienna, Austria. (I)

**Wed., Sept. 16 - VIENNA**

This morning we arrive in the Imperial City of Vienna, capital of Austria. Known as the "City Of Music," that inspired the creative genius of Mozart, Beethoven and Strauss. Our sightseeing tour through this "City of Waltzes" will visit both palaces and churches...we'll see the magnificent Gothic Cathedral of St. Stephen's and the Belvedere Palace. We will drive along the Ringstrasse to view the famous monuments including the Parliament, and State Opera House. (B,D)

**Thurs., Sept. 17 - VIENNA**

Today we walk in the footsteps of the Empress Maria Teresa as we tour the amazing Schönbrunn Palace. This afternoon is free in Vienna to enjoy one the famous Viennese coffee shops or stroll the pedestrian area. (B)

**Fri., Sept. 18 - VIENNA / ZELL AM SEE**

We depart Vienna today and explore the beautiful Wachau Valley. Enjoy a cruise on the Danube River passing rolling hills, vineyards and fortresses. Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned in the castle above the town of Dürnstein. We arrive in the town of Melk to visit the imposing 900-year-old Benedictine Abbey, a breathtaking example of baroque architecture, which overlooks the town from its dramatic hilltop location. After our visit to Melk, we'll return to our motor coach and make our way into the heart of the Austrian Alps to the resort village of Zell Am See. (B,D)

**Sat. Sept. 19 - ZELL AM SEE**

This morning we begin with a visit to a local farm where we learn about agriculture in the Austrian Tyrol. A short drive takes us to the village of St. Johann to experience the world's largest dumpling festival - Knödelfest. Of all the events in Tirol, the Knödelfest in St. Johann is the one which, by tradition, tastes the best. For over thirty years the St. Johann people have been dressing the longest dumpling table in the world, where every year 26,000 dumplings are served, in over twenty different varieties. Five music groups provide a fantastic atmosphere and great entertainment. Next, we visit the town of Oberndorf where we will enjoy a Tyrolean evening of local music, dancing, and dinner. (B,D)

**Sun. Sept. 20 - ZELL AM SEE (Eagles Nest)**

A magical day is in store for us, as we drive into Berchtesgaden Land. The combination of lakes and mountains makes this corner of Germany one of the most beautiful in all of Europe. We make a stop in Berchtesgaden where we have time to explore this medieval village with over 900 years of history. Next, we drive to the base of Mt. Kehlstein, where we board a special postal bus for a trip up the serpent-like Kehlsteinstraße, one of the most magnificent mountain roads in the world. Next, we enter a great tunnel on our way to the elevator that will transport us through the mountain to arrive at Kehlsteinhaus, Hitler's Eagle's Nest as named by the Allied Forces. From here, there is a magnificent view of the surrounding Alps. (B)

**Mon., Sept. 21 - ZELL AM SEE / GARMISCH**

We will begin our day by traveling to Innsbruck, the capital of the Austrian Tyrol, where we'll see the Wilten Basilica, one of the finest Rococo churches in the northern Tyrol, and the Triumphal Arch, which marks the beginning of the Maria-Theresien-Strasse. Once in the Old Town we'll see the 15th and 16th century houses, the Old Town Hall and Belfry, and the Little Golden Roof, a charming structure built by Friedrich the Pennyless to end jokes about his poverty. Free time will also be set aside to explore the picturesque quarter enclosed by the ring of streets known as the Moat, now a pedestrian zone. Afterward board a our train for a scenic journey into the Tyrolean and Bavaria Alps to arrive in the Bavarian resort town of Garmisch. (B,D)

**Tues., Sept. 22 - GARMISCH**

Today, we visit Munich, the capital city of Bavaria and the heart of artistic Germany. Cheerful and vivacious, boasting magnificent architecture from Bavaria's royal past, and we'll experience it all. We begin with a visit to the Marienplatz to witness the chiming of the "Glockenspiel" displaying a medieval tournament and dance. Next, we visit the world famous Oktoberfest that is celebrated at the "Wies'n" Fair Grounds. Ten huge festival tents of the seven Munich breweries welcome visitors and the lively brass bands add to the overwhelmingly happy sounds of this world-famous festival. Lunch and fun are included this afternoon. Later today we return to the Bavarian Alps and our hotel. (B,L)

**Wed., Sept. 23 - TYROL / BLACK FOREST**

Today we make our way through the Bavarian Alps passing the town of Fussen where we make a photo stop of Neuschwanstein Palace. Leaving Fussen, we'll travel the German Alpine Road that takes us across the Bavarian countryside where local farmers have made their mountain paradise into the great cheese manufacturing area of Germany to the shores of Lake Constance. We continue along the shores of Lake Constance into the Southern Black Forest and our hotel. (B,D)

**Thurs., Sept. 24 - BLACK FOREST (Taste of Switzerland)**

We enjoy a taste of Switzerland as we drive into the Swiss Alps to the shores of Lake Lucerne and the city of Lucerne. We will enjoy an introductory tour of Lucerne that will start at the Spreuer Bridge whose painted gables portray the "Dance of Death" paintings on wood in the triangles formed by the roof beams that depict the history of the city of Lucerne and Switzerland. Our walking tour will continue through the Old Town with its charming houses, painted facades and flower-decked fountains before ending with a view of the famous Lion Monument hewn out of natural rock in memory of the Swiss Guard. The afternoon is free to enjoy the scenery of this famous lakeside resort. We return to the Black Forest in the late afternoon. (B,D)

**Fri., Sept. 25 - BLACK FOREST / FRANKFURT**

Today, will take us through the mysterious Black Forest, passing pretty timber-framed houses, numerous abbeys, and castles set in idyllic valleys. Our first stop is the town of Triberg, where we can follow the historical trail of the clock carriers with a visit to the Black Forest Museum specializing in the exhibition of traditional costumes and local craftwork. Then we're headed to Gutach to visit the open air Black Forest Folklore and Farmhouse Museum to learn about the over 200 year history of farming in this fascinating region. Next we visit the village of Alpirsbach, situated on the Kinzig River and home to Alpirsbach Monastery. The monks began brewing beer in the middle ages, and in 1877 Johann Gottfried Glauner re-opened the Klosterbrau, which is operated today by fourth generation Glauners. We'll enjoy a tour of the brewery museum and learn about the traditional art of brewing, as well as enjoy a fresh brew of the Alpirsbacher Klosterbräu. This afternoon we continue to Frankfurt for our final dinner. (B,D)

**Sat., Sept. 26 - FRANKFURT / USA**

Today we drive to Frankfurt's International Airport for our flight returning us to Chicago. (B,I)
